GOALS

Mission statement:

- isirv works for the prevention, detection, treatment, and control
 of influenza and other respiratory virus diseases throughout
 the world.
- It does so through the exchange and dissemination of information, through facilitating the interaction of scientists and public health specialists, and by promoting international collaborative efforts against these diseases.

UNIQUE ATTRIBUTES

- Oversight and lead responsibility for organizing "Options for the Control of Influenza"
- First professional society in the field of influenza and other respiratory viruses to represent a large number of laboratories, clinical scientists and public health professionals around the world – 430 members currently

 - the Neuraminidase Inhibitor Susceptibility Network (NISN) is the first Special Interest Group of isirv, now known as the isirv Antiviral Group
